At Fairton Christian Center, the needs of the family are met in a variety of ways. *The Men's Ministries*, in conjunction with the Assemblies of God and Promise Keepers, provide the spiritual, social, and intimate one-on-one buddy system a man needs to be strong for his family. *The Women's Ministries* provide weekly Bible classes, monthly breakfasts, an annual retreat, and other social gatherings to encourage and strengthen women in their many roles both inside and outside the family. *Children's Church, Royal Rangers, Missionettes, Sunday School, Youth Group*, and other special activities provide children and young adults with opportunities to grow spiritually, mentally, and physically and to minister to others.

The Church. The church functions to meet the spiritual, social and physical needs of the congregation through weekly services, special guest speakers, musical events, and a variety of support ministries for every age. An intercessory prayer group meets regularly to pray for specific needs of the church, the community, and the world.

The School. Through Fairton Christian Center Academy, students learn the truth of God's Word as applied to the academic realm. Math, language, history, science, and social development are all approached through the eyes of Biblical truths. Children are shown that Biblical values and concepts form the foundation of all academic truth.

“Cookbook Recipe”

♥Saucy Chicken & Asparagus♥

- 1 ½ lbs. fresh asparagus spears, halved*
- 4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves*
- 2 tablespoons cooking oil*
- ½ teaspoon salt*
- ¼ teaspoon pepper*
- 1 (10¾ oz.) can condensed cream chicken soup, undiluted*
- ½ cup mayonnaise*
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice*
- ½ teaspoon curry powder*
- 1 (4 oz.) cup shredded cheddar cheese*

If desired, partially cook asparagus; drain. Place the asparagus in a greased 9-inch square baking dish. In a skillet over medium heat, brown the chicken in oil on both sides. Season with salt and pepper. Arrange chicken over asparagus. In a bowl, mix soup, mayonnaise, lemon juice and curry powder; pour over chicken, cover and bake at 375° for 40 minutes, sprinkle with cheese. Let stand for 5 minutes before serving.

Helpful Hints

Lettuce keeps better if you store it in the refrigerator without washing it. Keep the leaves dry. Wash lettuce the day you are going to use it.
