***The Church.*** The church functions to meet the spiritual, social and physical needs of the congregation through weekly services, special guest speakers, musical events, and a variety of support ministries for every age. An intercessory prayer group meets regularly to pray for specific needs of the church, the community, and the world.

***The School.*** Through Fairton Christian Center Academy, students learn the truth of God's Word as applied to the academic realm. Math, language, history, science, and social development are all approached through the eyes of Biblical truths. Children are shown that Biblical values and concepts form the foundation of all academic truth.

## “Cookbook Recipe”

### ♥*Chocolate Cherry Dessert*♥

- 1 (18-19 oz.) package chocolate cake mix
- 1 ¼ cups quick cooking oats, divided
- ½ cup margarine, softened
- 1 egg
- ½ cup chopped nuts
- ¼ cup packed brown sugar
- ½ teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 (21 oz.) can cherry pie filling

Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl combine cake mix, 1 cup oats and 6 tablespoons of margarine until crumbly. Reserve 1 cup crumbs. Press into a 9-inch deep dish pie plate forming a sort rim. Bake for 12 minutes. Meanwhile, to reserved crumbs, add remaining ¼ cup oats, 2 tablespoons margarine, nuts, sugar and cinnamon. Mix well. Remove base from oven and spread with pie filling. Sprinkle with reserved crumb mixture. Return to oven and bake 15-20 minutes till light golden brown. Cool completely. Cut into 12 wedges.

### *Helpful Hints*

When a recipe calls for packed brown sugar, fill the correct size measuring cup with the sugar, and then use the next smaller size cup to pack the brown sugar into its cup.
